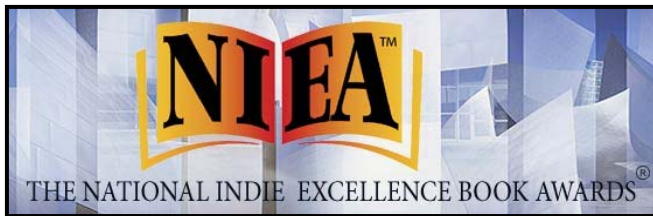
Suggested Interview Questions

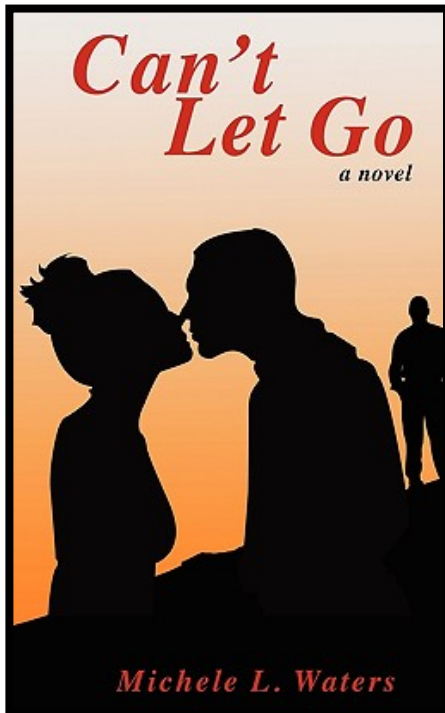

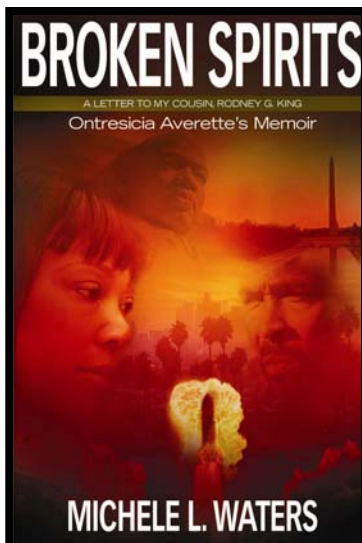
